Since we only covered the budget last month, this report will cover financial information since the beginning of the year. We started the year with a checking account balance of \$28,732. To that we added

\$5,978 in income attributed to Dues of \$3,120 and Fees for the Holiday Party of \$2,572. We spent \$5,321, which included the purchase of a new projector for the classroom of \$3,227, leaving the Club with a closing balance of \$29,388. In addition, we have a CD in the amount of \$20,922, giving us total assets of \$50,310.

**Monitors: Bill Dreyer**

The monitors are doing a great job of volunteering to keep the computer center open during a very busy time with classes and help sessions. We have trained and added (5) new monitors this year and we remain ready to train club members who would like to become a monitor. Monitoring is a good way to give back to our club. There is no technical skills required though we encourage our monitors to share whatever knowledge they can.

**Education: Robin Seaver**

Scheduling Jan and Feb Classes was dear Buckey's last Hurrah.

Of the 580 seats in 41 classes we offered, as of this morning 511 or 89% of seats were sold.

Debbie Dennis and Catherine Tracy did most of the scheduling for March and have added 31 classes to the calendar. March classes will be sold 2/17 starting at noon.
