Currently there are 3,246 members of the Computer Club. During the past 30 days, 34 new members joined the club and eight members renewed their memberships.

On June 17, 2024 an email letter was sent to 102 club members who use Spectrum's Roadrunner (rr.com) email service explaining the "Bounce Back" problem and asking them to complete a short questionnaire concerning their experience with Roadrunner. Copies of that email and the questionnaire are attached to these minutes.

To date, 25 members have completed the questionnaire with the following results:

- 10 received the most recent copy of the weekly Events Calendar.
- 15 did not receive the most recent copy of the weekly Events Calendar.
- 15 have alternate email addresses.
- 9 gave permission to switch to their alternate email address.
- 11 indicated that they are interested in changing email addresses.

For those members who granted permission, Roadrunner addresses have been replaced with alternate addresses in the club's listserv. The alternate addresses

will be shared with the SIG leaders when all surveys have been returned and processed.

Because survey responses are still being returned, a follow-up report will be presented at the August staff meeting.

Changes have been made to the wording above the Quick Links. The committee is developing a Google Form to collect information from Members who volunteered to participate in additional surveys from last summer's survey. Inadvertently, I shared the Practice Website with Board members last week. I should have sent the graphic shared during the May Board/Staff meeting. The URL provided access to the Sub-Tabs that are in a developmental stage. These items are intended as placeholders as we move forward with the establishment of the proper links and information this summer and into the fall.

As you know we always need more helpers. To that end, Toni put out a plug on Facebook and we received four names who expressed interest. Also, information was sent to the people who asked for more information on the survey. At this point, I have had no responses. Treasurer's Report Through items posted as of 6/24/2024

June's opening balance was \$32,428. Income for the period was \$1,472 made up of \$500 of membership dues, \$910 in education class fees and \$62 in open room cash. Facility expenses were \$3,377 made up primarily in Capital Equipment of \$3365 and a monthly subscription of \$12. Our ending balance for the month was \$30,130. Our \$20,580 CD matured on June 11th, providing an interest of \$421. We renewed it for five months at 4.4%.

Roadrunner Email sent on June 17, 2024

The Sun City Computer Club has determined that you and other members who use "Roadrunner" as their email provider may not be receiving all emails from the club. We would like to correct this situation so that you can take full advantage of the many programs and services of the club. Please help us work on a solution to this problem by filling out this survey form: [Click For Roadrunner Questionnaire](#)

Roadrunner email addresses end in [rr.com](#) and are hosted by Spectrum internet services. Unlike most other email providers, Roadrunner limits the number of emails that it will process from a sender or for a person receiving emails. For the Computer Club, and perhaps you, this means that the weekly Computer Club Events Calendar that is emailed each Sunday "bounces back" through our listserv and, therefore, is not delivered to you. This may also be blocking other emails from your friends and family, the Computer Club and other organizations.

There are also reports that Spectrum is easing out its email service, as Hargray did recently.

Our research indicates that this is a common concern for many clubs and organizations that send mass emails. Unfortunately, there doesn't seem to be an easy solution to the problem. It may mean that switching to another email is the only answer for you. If that is the case, and if you desire, the Computer Club will help you transition to a new email provider.

For assistance moving to a new email provider we recommended that you attend a regularly scheduled Computer Club "Walk-In Help Session". Help Sessions are held in the

club room on Tuesdays 10:00 -12:00, Wednesdays 2:00 - 4:00, Thursdays 10:00 - 12:00, and Saturdays 10:00 - 12:00.
