Our opening cash balance for 2025 was \$28,878.

During the year we had income in the amount of \$51,550 and when compared to our budget we show a favorable balance of \$6,550. This is mainly attributable to our membership dues coming in higher than anticipated.

Our general and administrative expenses were lower than budget by \$6,607 and was the result of our holiday party attendance being lower than we expected.

We spent no money on educational expenses, although we billed \$5,280 in class fees.

Facility expenses for the period were \$22,284 and when compared to our budget, we were favorable by \$14,916. Capital and non-capital expenditures were lower than anticipated by \$13,122.

Our SIG expenses for the period were also lower than anticipated by \$2,620.

Overall our ending cash balance was \$41,971. Our Certificates of Deposit amounted to \$32,867, giving us a year-end cash balance of \$74,838. Included in this amount is \$20,925, representing membership dues collected for 2026, so our net adjusted cash and CD balance for the year was \$53,913.

Program Speaker:

It's my pleasure to introduce Kathy Turco as our speaker for today's meeting. Kathy Turco has lived in Sun City for the last seven years. She retired from the federal government as a Chief Financial Officer serving at several agencies including Veterans Affairs, GSA, the IRS and the office of Management and Budget. Today she is presenting the annual "file electronically" presentation with an emphasis on using electronic filing and direct deposit for your refund; however, she will also discuss some tax law changes including the Big Beautiful Bill of 2025. While Kathy is very knowledgeable about finance, she is not a tax professional, so she encourages you to seek out a tax accountant or expert for your individual tax questions.
