Since we did not have a meeting last month, I'll give you an update for the first two months of this year. Our opening balance for the year was \$41,971. We had income of \$7,248. Included in this amount was \$5,800 of membership dues collected, \$525 of education class fees and we had open room cash sales of \$923.

During the period we had \$256 in general administrative expense mainly attributable to \$175, Gift Card promotions for our officers election and our club survey. Printing supplies of \$1,007 and non-capital hardware of \$218 were the major components of the \$1,551 of facility expenses. We also had \$293 of SIG expenses related to subscriptions and a Genealogy Speaker Honorarium. Total expenses for the period were \$2,1001.

Our resulting cash balance at the end of February is \$47,117.
